Join us for a Saturday story time and take home a fun craft packet.

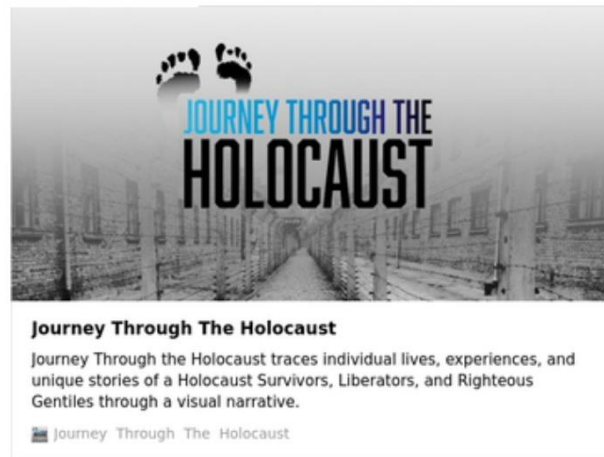

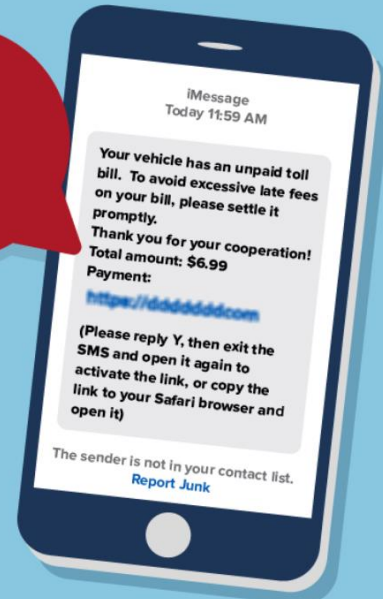


In need of WIFI? Don't have service? Check in with us and we may be able to check a hotspot out to you so you can gain access to the Internet with the devices you already have.

# Things to know

Got a text telling you to pay “overdue toll charges”?

**It's probably a scam.**



This particular scam is occurring a lot. It's one of a type of scam called Phishing.

## PHISHING

Phishing is the type of scam that tricks you into clicking on a link, or downloading malware. This allows the scammer to gain valuable information such as passwords, personal data or financial data.

**Do not click on links sent via text or email.** If you are worried that a message might be legitimate or want to check navigate to the website via a web browser and log in to the account you are worried about from there.
